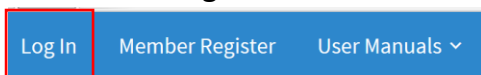
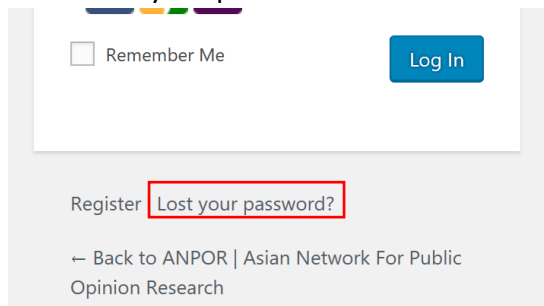


## Lost and Reset Password

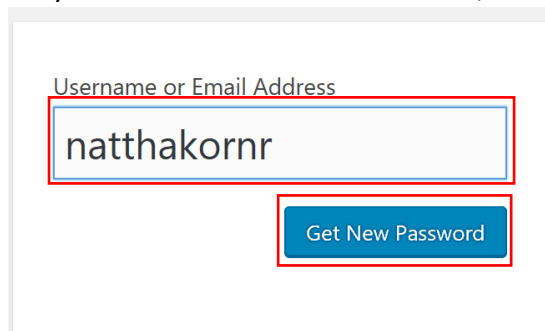
1. Click menu “Login”.
